
## How to remove the SpeedControl Dial from a wheelchair frame Option A: direct attachment

- 1. Locate the clamp and bolt.
- 2. Find the clamp holding the SpeedControl Dial to the wheelchair frame. It wraps around the frame tube and is attached with a square head bolt and hex nut.
- 3. Loosen the clamp.
- 4. Use a flathead screwdriver or the provided external hex wrench to loosen the hex nut until the clamp starts to open.
- 5. Remove the hex nut and bolt.
- 6. Unscrew the hex nut completely and slide the bolt out of the clamp and housing.
- 7. Unhook the clamp.
- 8. Gently pull the clamp away from the housing and remove it from the frame tube.
- 9. Remove the rubber insert (if used) If a rubber insert was used between the clamp and frame, slide it off the tubing.
- 10. Unclip and disconnect the cable.
- 11. Disconnect the cable from the SmartDrive system and carefully remove any hook-and-loop strips or tie-straps used to secure it to the chair.







## How to remove the SpeedControl Dial from a wheelchair frame

## Option B: with extension arm

- 1. Locate the clamp and arm assembly.
- 2. Find where the extension arm is attached to the frame using a clamp, bolt, and hex nut.
- 3. Loosen the hex nut.
- 4. Use a flathead screwdriver or the provided hex wrench to loosen the hex nut on the bolt.
- 5. Remove the hex nut and bolt.
- 6. Unscrew the hex nut completely and slide the bolt out of the arm bracket and clamp.
- 7. Detach the arm from the clamp.
- 8. Carefully unhook the top of the arm from the clamp.
- 9. Remove the clamp and rubber insert (if used).
- 10. Slide the clamp and any rubber insert off the frame tube.
- 11. Unclip and disconnect the cable
- 12. Disconnect the cable from SmartDrive and remove any tiestraps or Velcro securing it to the chair.
