

COMBINATION AGREEMENT

The MAX MOBILITY, LLC medical devices mentioned below are generally appropriate to be combined with the TILITE, LLC medical devices mentioned below provided that the combination of products is done by fully trained individual(s) and in accordance with instructions and restrictions of both manufacturers. Questions regarding any specific installation or performance criteria relating to a specific product or component should be directed to the manufacturer of that specific component.

All mounting instructions for the Max Mobility medical devices should be followed, as outlined in the relevant operations manual provided with each medical device. This includes compliance with all warnings, cautions, and instructions, including, but not limited to, all minimum and maximum dimensional requirements, minimum and maximum torque specifications, all weight limitations, and all maintenance recommendations.

Modifying components from either manufacturer by machining, bending, welding, or any other method is not allowed and may void this combination agreement.

The necessary fittings must be placed onto the basic frame of the wheelchair. If it is necessary to place the fittings on other parts of the wheelchair, the specific location must be agreed upon by both parties.

This Combination Agreement shall continue indefinitely from its execution. However, it can be terminated by either party in writing by giving thirty (30)-days' notice.
